<p><i>Airen Sauvignon, Castillo del Moro, Spain</i> This modern, crisp white from southern Spain has delicious crisp apple fruit flavours coupled with the citrusy twang of the zesty Sauvignon Blanc. Sensational drunk on its own or with salads and seafood.</p>	4.50	5.95	16.50
<p><i>Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, Sherwood, New Zealand</i> A pronounced, herbaceous nose with plenty of ripe gooseberries, guava and nettles on the nose - very typically Marlborough style. The palate is crisp, racy and mouth-watering with hints of grapefruit, guava and gooseberry followed by a long, enticing finish.</p>	5.95	7.95	21.50
<p><i>Pinot Grigio IGT Delle Venezie, Casa Defra, Italy</i> A deliciously refreshing white with subtle citrus hints and easy drinking style. Crisp, dry and very moreish.</p>	5.25	7.65	18.95

<p><i>Merlot 'The Exhibitionist' One Chain Vineyards, Australia</i> There's no holding back here, not much decorum to mention but what this wine lacks in modesty, it more than makes up for in enjoyment. Flirting outrageously with your tastebuds, The Exhibitionist is a one wine drama with a fruit filled plot and a memorably silky denouement. <p><i>Pinot Noir, Nostros, Chile</i> A light, fragrant red made from grapes grown in the cooler Casablanca region of Chile. Bright, wild strawberry and raspberry fruits dominate a soft, supple palate which leads through to a gentle, warming finish.</p>	5.95	7.85	21.50
<p><i>Rioja, Orgulio (Pride), Spain</i> This deliciously succulent Rioja is brim full of ripe damson fruit overlaid with smoky oak. Well balanced, concentrated and supple with a vanilla laced, juicy finish.</p>	6.95	9.25	26.90
<p><i>Chateau Ka Cadet de KA (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah), Lebanon</i> Lebanon is often purported to be the true home of the grapevine with a winemaking history dating back many centuries. More recently, Chateau Ka, based in the Bekaa Valley has become acclaimed for its stylish new wines. <b>Graham's Vintage Port, Portugal</b> This excellent Vintage has an intense colour with a deep, purple rim. On the nose shows a luscious ripeness with attractive floral aromas and undertones of black cherry. On the palate, a typically Graham's full-bodied structure, packed with layers and layers of fruit and firm tannins. The very long, accomplished finish indicates a great Vintage for long-term ageing.			6.50

<b>Grandjo Late Harvest Halves (Sweet), Portugal</b> One of the most remarkable dessert wines in the world, Grandjo Late Harvest is made from Semillon grapes harvested high up in the Douro region – a region better known for its hefty fortified wines. This however, is perfumed, delicate yet profound with luscious honeyed apple, apricot and vanilla notes offset by a delicious crisp, well balanced finish.			4.50
<b>Brilliant Disguise 100% Moscato (Sweet), Australia</b> Summer in a glass! Free run juice from old Muscat vines in the Barossa Valley are used to make this brilliant take on the Italian Moscato idea. Gently frizzante, tantalisingly sweet, beautifully aromatic, delicately low in alcohol - could there be anything more perfect for light desserts or cool summer sipping?			3.95

### ***Macon Fuisse, Dom de Fussiacus, France***

**29.90**

This small domaine make fine examples of the best that southern Burgundy has to offer. A rich, generous wine with ripe citrus fruits and hints of the tropical. Crisp acidity balances and buttery, toasty oak completes the picture.

### ***Chablis, Domaine Bernard Defaix, France***

**28.60**

A top notch example from a respected grower. Defaix Chablis displays minerally, flinty notes on the nose with touches of green apple. The palate is elegant, dry and characterised by crisp, citrus flavours overlaid with smoky notes. Long, complex finish.

### ***Albarino, Castel de Bouza, Spain***

**24.80**

Produced by a cooperative of just 5 vineyard owners, Castel de Bouza have access to great fruit from which they make classic Albarino. Bright, citrusy and minerally on the nose with a crisp, almost riesling like character on the palate with hints of lemon and mineral. Brilliant seafood or shell fish partner!

### ***Chenin Blanc Original, South Africa***

**22.50**

Packed with succulent flavours of apple, pineapple and citrus with hints of ginger, honeysuckle and orange blossom and a lovely minerality. Bright and tasty it is made without any oak to preserve the grape's "original" vibrant fresh fruit character.

### *Cabernet Shiraz 'The Musician' Majella, Australia*

24.50

Using the same fabulous fruit that goes into the much revered Majella Cabernets and Shiraz, Musician is younger, more fruit driven version using a little less new oak. Very much in the mould of its big brothers with crisp, blackcurrant, eucalypt and mint on the nose followed by a huge whack of juicy, savoury fruit on the palate. This is pure Coonawarra at a bargain price – awesome!

### *Serie A Malbec, Argentina*

24.90

Argentina's Malbec is a great partner with the steaks that have made Argentina a gastronomic destination. This wine, made from lower yielding grapes, is concentrated and rich yet supple and appealing. Lots of ripe, plummy fruit character with hints of spice and mocha.

### *Pinot Noir Yarra Valley, Australia*

31.50

Low yields resulted in concentrated fully ripe grapes which offer up flavours of ripe cherry and strawberry combining with subtle notes of cloves and spice. The restrained French oak add some toasty, savoury complexity as well as hints of coffee and mocha. The finish is lifted and pure with wild strawberry notes and a warm, velvety texture

### *Chateau Lamothe Cissac Haut Medoc, Cru Bourgeois, France*

29.90

A traditional style of Bordeaux that has elegance and savoury fruit in abundance. Medium bodied with well integrated tannins and cedary oak flavours on a long, complex finish.

### *Syrah 'Steinbeck Vineyard', California*

39.00

Eberle have made their name for the Rhone varietals that they produce and this dense, concentrated Syrah is good reason why. Richly textured with supple brambly fruit overlaid with chocolatey, toasty oak character.

### *Cillar de Silos Rosado, Spain*

24.90

Imagine crushing ultra ripe strawberries then macerating them in kirsch for a little while - well, that's what you're dealing with here. It's an explosion of ripe fruit counterbalanced nicely by some savoury elements to provide balance and interest.
